Job Description

This position is responsible for managing the staff and workload of the Medical Physics Department, including staff hiring, supervision, performance management, training, and discipline duties. In this role, the Manager is responsible for scheduling appropriate staff to support patient schedules and ensure quality and appropriateness of healthcare provided in the department, including assessment of treatment plans, and accuracy of records. The Manager is responsible for ensuring Practice knowledge of, and observance of, State and Federal rules and regulations regarding the safe use of radioactive materials and radioactive producing machines.

Major Job Responsibilities:

- Provide management to the Medical Physics Department, including day-to-day supervision and scheduling
- Direct staff in planning/reviewing treatment plans prior to treatment and performing additional weekly checks to ensure proper delivery of the treatment plans
- Ensures the Linear accelerators and Proton accelerator are functioning safely, calibrated and produce stable radiation beams
- Ensures radioactive material records are maintained per legal and safety requirements
- Helps the Radiation Safety Officer maintain legal records for the State of Florida
- Ensure Medical Physicists review all patient dosimetry, secondary dosimetry checks and conducts weekly chart reviews during radiation treatment courses
- Provides technical support to the medical patient plan developed by the Radiation Oncologist
- Assists, as requested by physician, in areas of patient treatment modality, equipment selection and utilization

- Certification by the American Board of Radiology
- 7+ Years' medical physicist experience in a radiation oncology facility
- Experience with SRS and HDR planning
