Jacksonville, FL. — This September, Ackerman Cancer Center will add several new support programs to its wellness calendar, including the Living with Lung Cancer Support Network. Lung cancer is the second most common cancer diagnosed in both men and women, and it accounts for 14% of all new cancer cases each year.
